

## **Arrival by Public Transport**

Exit Station Griebnitzsee

From **Berlin Central Station** with S-Bahn S7, direction Potsdam-Hauptbahnhof (~35 min).

From **Potsdam Central Station** with S-Bahn S7, direction Ahrensfelde (~10 min).

From **BER Airport Terminal 1-2** with RB22, direction Friedrichstraße (~60 min). Alternatively with RB14, direction Nauen or with RE7, direction Dessau to **S Ostkreuz**; from there with S7, direction Potsdam-Hauptbahnhof (~60 min).

At **S Griebnitzsee** go downstairs and to the right. Keep left on the exit and cross the bus station. Continue past the library until you reach the main building at the end of the campus. Take the elevator to the 3rd floor, where the d-school is located.

## Arrival by Car

A 10 to HPI Campus

From A10 (Berlin beltway), change onto A115 at the intersection **Dreieck Nutheta**l. Leave A115 at the **exit Potsdam-Babelsberg** and continue in this direction. Follow Nuthestr. towards the city center "Zentrum" and exit at **Wetzlarer Str.** (Medienstadt Babelsberg). Turn right, pass the BMW dealership and turn left in the direction of Babelsberg. At the next intersection (Großbeerenstr./Wetzlarer Str.) keep going straight onto August-Bebel-Str.

To the Main building (H): After 1.5 km, just before the rail underpass, turn right onto Prof.–Dr.–Helmert–Str.. At the end of the street, next to the bus loop, you will see the HPI on your right side.

Taxi rides from **Berlin Central Station** to HPI d-school cost 30 € to 40 € and take ~45 minutes. A taxi ride from **Potsdam Central Station** should cost 10 € and take ~15 minutes. A taxi ride from **BER Airport** to HPI costs 40 € to 50 € and takes up to 60 minutes.
