Hasso Plattner Institute (HPI) in Potsdam is Germany's university excellence center for digital engineering. With the bachelor's and master's degree programs in "IT Systems Engineering," the Faculty for Digital Engineering at the University of Potsdam offers an especially practical and engineering-oriented study program in computer science that is unique throughout Germany. The HPI School of Design Thinking (HPI D-School) was founded by Hasso Plattner in Potsdam in 2007 based on the model

of the Stanford d.school. Since then it has become the European center for Design Thinking education. Every year, the HPI D-School offers 400 places for a supplementary study course in the Design Thinking innovation approach. The HPI Academy offers trainings for professionals. The HPI-Stanford Design Thinking Research Program strives to apply rigorous academic methods to understand how and why Design Thinking innovation works and fails.




