








Call for participation

The d.confestival is a unique event and brings together international innovators and multidisciplinary thinkers from management, education, and research. From 14 to 16 September 2017 the d.confestival will take place for the second time and will be celebrating 10 years of HPI School of Design Thinking. 1,000 participants and 150 speakers from 350 companies and 40 nations are expected. On their three-day journey, participants will experience a wide range of activities such as presentations, exhibitions, discussions, workshops, and other multidisciplinary activities that provide the Design Thinking community with the opportunity to share their insights and methods.

What do we need from you?


- → Title
- → Key words

- → **Abstract** to announce your submission (max. 500 characters)
- → Agenda/Concept
- Contact details of organizer/organizing committee members (names, affiliations, and email addresses)
- Duration
- **Target Group**
- → Maximum number of participants (only for workshops and activities)
- Required equipment (basic equipment for technology and Design Thinking material will be provided)

Process



- → Please submit your proposal as a **PPT/PDF document** in English (max. 4 pages) and (this is optional) as a **video** of up to 2 minutes.
- → **Send your contribution** till March 15, 2017 to dconfestival2017@hpi.de with the subject "Call for Participation".
- → **Upload your video** on WeTransfer till March 15, 2017 and send it to dconfestival2017@hpi.de with the subject "Call for Participation".
- Our program team will review your contribution and will let you know if your submission is accepted until April 15, 2017.
- Be creative, so do not expect further guidelines on how your application should look it's time to design think our future!
