





### **Goal: Update Each Other and the Project Stakeholders**

- Synchronize teams and share project progress
- Celebrate wins and show off what was built
- Get feedback from all team members, stakeholders and customer
- Provide occasion for overall project reflection
- Presentation can be split into separate parts
  - □ E.g. "official product demo" and "internal project reflection"

### Organization

- Product Owners and Project Managers most likely currently have the best overview of the overall system roadmap and can coordinate
- Teams contribute their ideas and content (moderated by SM?)





#### **Possible Content**

- Live demo of the system showing "happy case" workflow
  - ☐ Use case that shows of the best features
- Current state of the **development roadmap** 
  - □ What is already done, what was unrealistic, what is planned next
  - Outlook on where the project could be at the end of the semester
- Insights into team and project organization
  - ☐ How was work structured, how id teams collaborate
  - □ Ongoing challenges to tackle in the future
- **Updates** from the initial presentation
  - □ What has changed in the meantime?

These are initial ideas, customize to suit your specific project context



#### **Possible Content**

- Technology and implementation details
  - □ Solutions that make you especially proud
  - □ Application architecture, rationale and design decisions
  - □ Data organization
  - □ Employed libraries and selection criteria
- Lessons learned in the project until now
  - □ What you wish you would have known at project start
  - □ How to continue learning in the rest of the semester?

Diagrams can help illustrate complex structures







#### **More Possible Content**

- Details that teams consider relevant for everyone
- Guidelines that should be shared with everyone
- Information that is relevant for stakeholders going forward
